In March of 2020, our team went remote on short notice due to pandemic. Our delivery of programming was uninterrupted. We launched right into reaching out, and handling calls from hundreds of business owners. We launched a launch a daily Covid Coffee Chat for business owners with 7-25 daily attendees and discussed programs, impacts, and emotions. We brought in local MP's, Economic Development representatives, WorksafeBC, lawyer etc. As a group we helped business owners navigate the CEWS, CEBA, RRRF, CERB, WorkSafe, HR issues, CCRA etc. We also were a local partner in the Stay At Home Gala, a nationwide initiative to raise funds for Community Foundations, but also to have an event to break-up the stay-at-home boredom.

We were then thrilled to hear the Prime Minister mention in a daily address that Community Futures was selected as a partner to deliver hundreds of millions of dollars in business and community financial support. We really stepped up to the plate, writing 131 loans totaling \$3.9MM dollars of support for businesses in the South Okanagan Similkameen.

We also helped with business owners with businesses advisory services (441) and training 1038 session participants. Community Futures is here to help transition our local businesses once again into a new normal, going into the 2021-22 operational year.
